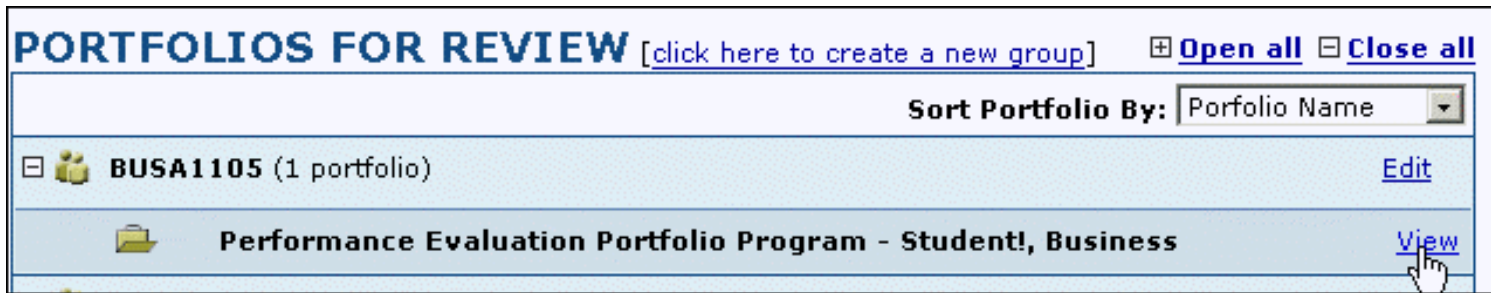



## Viewing PEPP Assignments

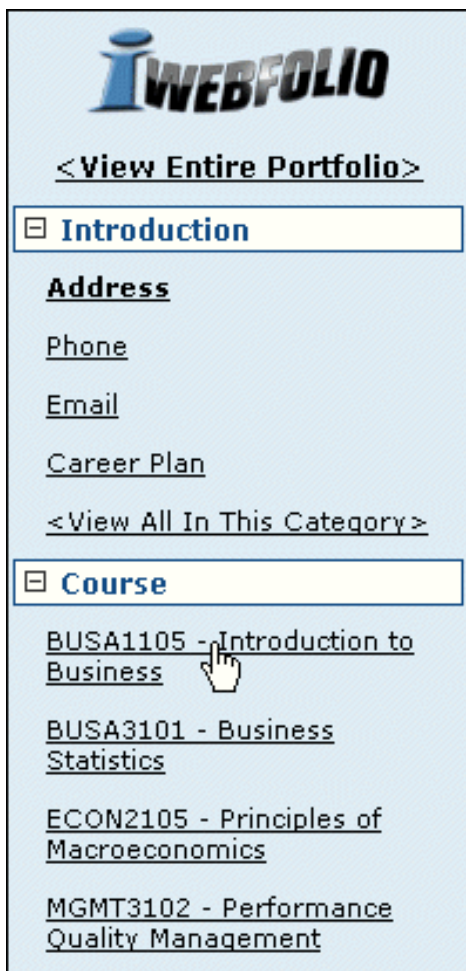
